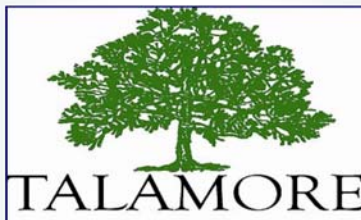

Summer School Offerings 2022

All transcripts for successful recovery must be received at the Jr./Sr. High School Office by August 30th.

All courses chosen for Credit Recovery must be specifically labeled as Credit Recovery courses and/or described as **full course** options. Students may not choose a .5 credit or 1/2 Semester course to fulfill his/her summer school requirement. If the option is provided, the student must choose the full course. 1/2 Semester courses will only receive .5 credit and will not fulfill the credit recovery requirement.
