# SAT exam at CCA this Saturday, November 6<sup>th</sup>.

The test will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m.

### Masks are required as we are a CollegeBoard testing site.

#### ID and Registration Ticket are also required.

CollegeBoard will NOT allow students to take the SAT exam without a mask, ID, & registration ticket.

Please have your child to CCA by 7:45 a.m. (if not earlier to settle in) as this test is a standardized test that must begin promptly at 8:00 a.m.

We will not be allowed to have a student enter the testing room after the testing has begun.

#### The Standard Administration of the exam will end at or around 12:45 p.m.

The **Non-Standard Administration** of the exam (for students that are approved by CollegeBoard for extended time) will end at or around **2:15 p.m.** 

Your child will should bring a few #2 pencils, a calculator, as well as a snack to have during the break times.

(No mechanical pencils are allowed, not even #2 mechanical pencils – traditional, #2 pencils only)

## Please pre-screen your child with the following CollegeBoard COVID-19 statements/questions:

SAT Test Center Covid-19 Safety Screening

Both students and staff will be asked to confirm their agreement with four statements before they can be admitted to a test center. Testing staff will deny entry to any student who doesn't confirm all the statements below or refuses to answer them.

- You do not have covid-19 or reason to believe you have covid-19. Symptoms of covid-19 include cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- You agree to wear a mask the entire time you're at this test site.
- You agree to follow the health and safety guidelines in place in this test site as instructed by testing staff. **NOTE:** Testing staff will follow the most stringent guidelines in effect for this site.
- By entering the testing room, you're accepting the risk of covid-19 exposure. While we have taken measures to help create a safe environment, unfortunately it isn't possible to remove all risk.

## CCA has implemented the following COVID-19 regulations for the SSAT exam:

- Testing rooms will have no more than 10 students and 1 proctor.
- Masks will be worn at all times. Per CollegeBoard, no mask breaks are allowed. \*CCA will offer one snack break in the classroom at the midpoint of the exam. Students may remove masks to eat a snack but only while seated and socially distanced.
- All classrooms and bathrooms have been cleaned and sanitized.
- Students with obvious signs of illness will be removed from the testing room. Please do not send your child to take the SAT exam in he/she is showing any signs of illness.
