Calvary Christian Academy Student Device Frequently Asked Questions



1. Can a student use their cell phone in school?


- a. For making phone calls Yes, but only at the H.S. Office.
- b. For playing games No, Never during the school day 8:45am-3:00pm
- c. For researching Yes, <u>but NOT on CCA WiFi and only with teacher permission and teacher</u> monitoring
- d. Cell phone use in the classroom should be rare. We do not want it to be a common practice by teachers/students.
 - 1. Exceptions: Yearbook and Computer Science classes still NO WiFi allowed.
 - 2. If used outside the classroom students must have pass/Yearbook ID if they do not, teachers must take the phone.

2. Can a student use their registered technology (iPad, tablet, laptop) in school?

- a. For playing games No, Never during the school day 8:45am-3:00pm
- b. For researching, studying or working on a project Yes, but only with teacher permission and teacher monitoring

3. Can a student with WiFi access log on to a school desktop computer at 8:30am?

a. No, their WiFi permission places them in a different bracket that only affords them access to both CCA WiFi and desktop access from 9:00-3:00. There is no way currently to amend this process as the log on username and password for both WiFi and Desktop are the same. We do not want students to log onto the WiFi without teacher monitoring between 7:00 and 9:00am.



- a. For researching, studying or working on a project Yes, but only with Study Hall teacher permission and teacher monitoring
- b. For playing games No, Never during the school day 8:45am-3:00pm

5. Can a student use their registered technology (iPad, tablet, laptop) during Lunch?

a. No

6. Does every student with a registered device have CCA WiFi permission?

- a. Yes. If a student registers their personal device and has the WiFi permission form signed, they will receive WiFi access.
- b. If a student has an iPad with his/her own data plan, he/she still must have teacher permission to go online.

7. What happens if a student is using their device without permission, or in an unapproved fashion? Any phone or electronic device seen or heard by an authority figure will be taken to the high school office.

- 1st offense device will be returned to the student at 3:00 and a conduct referral will be issued
- 2nd offense device will be returned to the student at 3:00 and a detention will be issued
- 3rd offense device will be returned to the student and an In-School Suspension will be issued
- 4th offense the student will be required to drop off the phone at the high school office every morning.
